Miami-Dade County has launched a series of county directed efforts to improve access to primary care in South Miami-Dade through the *Building Better Communities General Obligations Bond Program (GOB Program)*. These efforts towards community-based planning encompass the service area of the Community Health Center of South Florida (CHI), Jackson South Community Hospital and the newly established Baptist Health South Florida Homestead Hospital.

The Office of Countywide Healthcare Planning is charged with leading the collaborative community planning strategy process for GOB funds through the expansion of the health care system in South Miami-Dade. The South Miami-Dade Health Profile was created as a resource document to enrich the data driven planning process. The profile provides a general overview of the population, health needs and resources available in the South Miami-Dade Service Area which encompasses Lower South Miami-Dade (zip codes 33030, 33031, 33032, 33033, 33034, 33035, 33039, 33170, 33190) and Upper South Miami-Dade (zip codes 33156, 33157, 33158, 33176, 33177, 33186, 33187, 33189, 33196). The geographic boundaries of the Upper South Miami-Dade area are SW 88th Street to the North, SW 216th Street to the South, Coastal line to the East, and SW 297th Avenue to the West. Lower South Miami-Dade boundaries are SW 216th Street to the North, Ingraham Hwy. to the South, Coastal line to the East, and Main Park Road to the West.

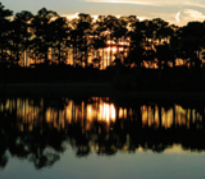
