



## Policy, Planning and Advisory Committee (PPAC)

“PPAC” is the Policy, Planning and Advisory Committee of the Health Council of South Florida, Inc. a private non-profit organization operating for more than 40 years to ensure that the development of health services, work force, and facilities meet identified health care needs in an efficient and cost effective manner for all residents. The Health Council of South Florida is one of eleven local planning councils throughout the state of Florida. They are authorized to exist by Florida Statute with baseline funding provided by the Department of Health and the county commissions, and augmented by other state, local and private resources. A Board of Directors governs the Council, and the Policy, Planning and Advisory Committee is a standing committee of the Board.



The PPAC should be persons broadly representatives of the South Florida community and should include a number of individuals as determined by the Board of Directors from time to time.

This Committee is expected to advise on Miami-Dade and Monroe Counties community strategic planning, legislative agenda and other policy recommendations as requested by the Board.

As a member of PPAC, you are actively contributing to your community by assuring that health services and facilities are accessible and affordable.

As a PPAC member, your responsibilities include:

- Attending at least six meetings for the year to discuss health planning and health policy;
- Reviewing the e-packet that you will receive before each PPAC meeting;
- Participating in strategic planning for Miami-Dade and Monroe Counties;
- Providing recommendations for the HCSF’s legislative agenda; and
- Selecting the recipient of the HCSF Annual Scholarship Award

The staff of the Health Council of South Florida handles the logistics of the meetings (such as e-packets and minutes), and creates the actual drafts of the products that you will review.
