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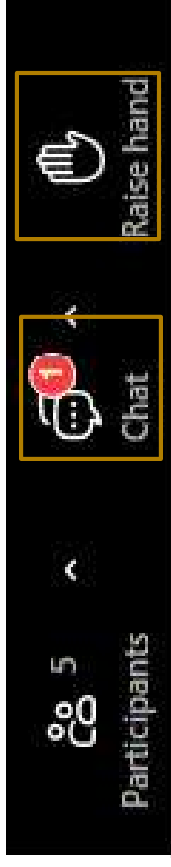

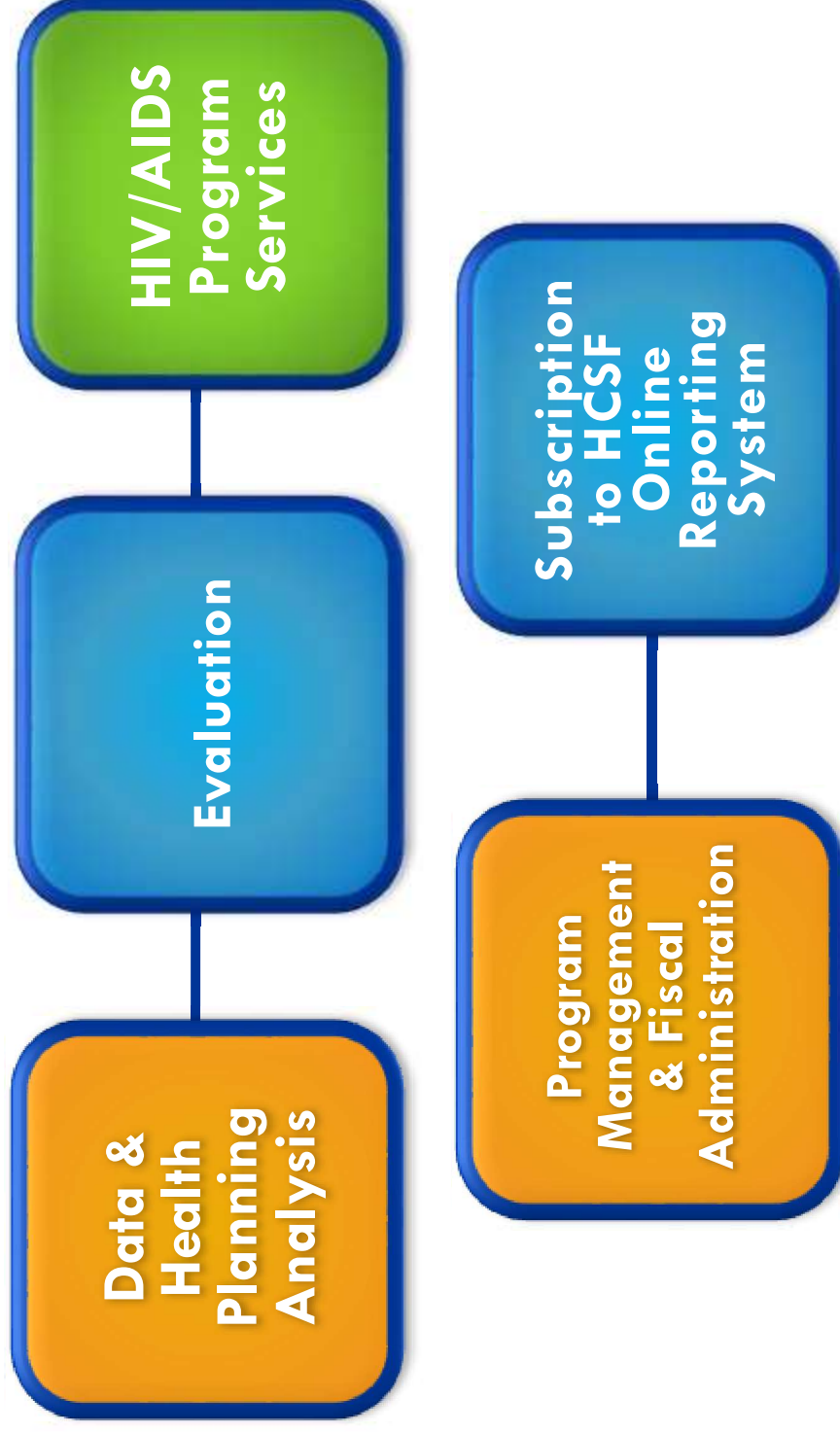

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# What is a needs assessment?



- A needs assessment is the process of determining the health and healthcare needs of any given population or sub-group in an area (i.e. Allapattah)
- It provides community leaders with a snapshot of local policy, systems, and environmental change strategies currently in place and helps to identify areas for improvement

# Allapattah Needs Assessment

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- ❑ This initiative was a collaboration with the Florida Blue Foundation and Florida International University's Green Family Foundation NeighborhoodHELP program to implement an improved health model within Allapattah
- ❑ Both qualitative and quantitative data collection were employed to capture a comprehensive portrait of the community, ensuring that we have a deep understanding of the community dynamics
- ❑ This was necessary to appropriately address the needs expressed by Allapattah residents and to promote effective action based on the results of the needs assessment process



# Why?



- To make sure any actions taken align with the needs expressed by residents of the Allapattah community
- To get a more honest and objective description of the needs than people might tell you publicly
- To promote effective action based on the results of the needs assessment process, such as the implementation of initiatives and policies that address the needs expressed by residents of Allapattah
- To apply the NHELP model to address the needs identified during this process

## Questions to Consider:

- What do we want to accomplish?
- Who are we going to talk to in the community?
- How will the results be used?

# Why is Measuring Health Important?



- ❑ Observe Community Health Status
- ❑ Understand Drivers of Health (social determinants)
- ❑ Create or Improve Health Care and Policy
- ❑ Identify Population Health Needs/Satisfaction (needs assessments)
- ❑ Conduct Continuous Quality Improvement (evaluation)

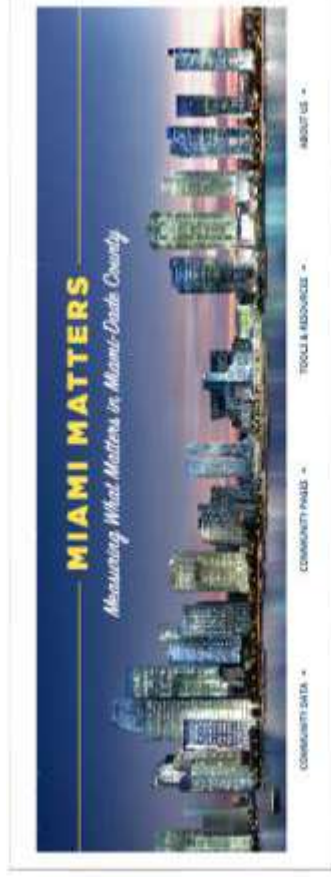

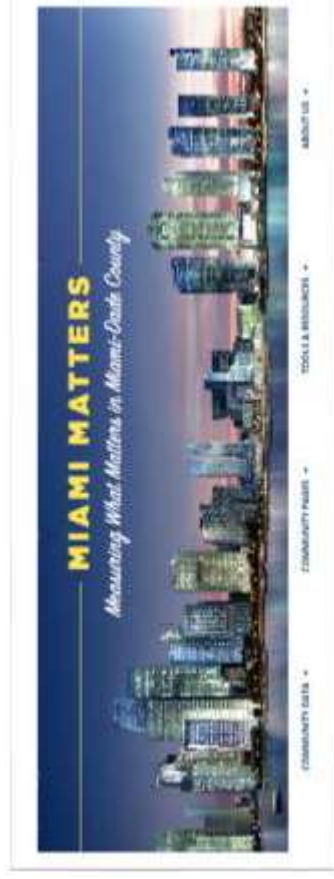


# Allapattah Needs Assessment: Miami-Dade Matters: Ambulatory Care-Sensitive Conditions

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ACSCs conditions are acute or chronic health conditions that lead to potentially preventable hospitalizations which could have been treated in an outpatient primary care setting

- ☐ Long-term complications of diabetes
- ☐ Uncontrolled diabetes
- ☐ Heart failure
- ☐ Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- ☐ Low-birth weight
- ☐ Hypertension
- ☐ Pediatric Asthma
- ☐ Urinary Tract Infections (UTIs)

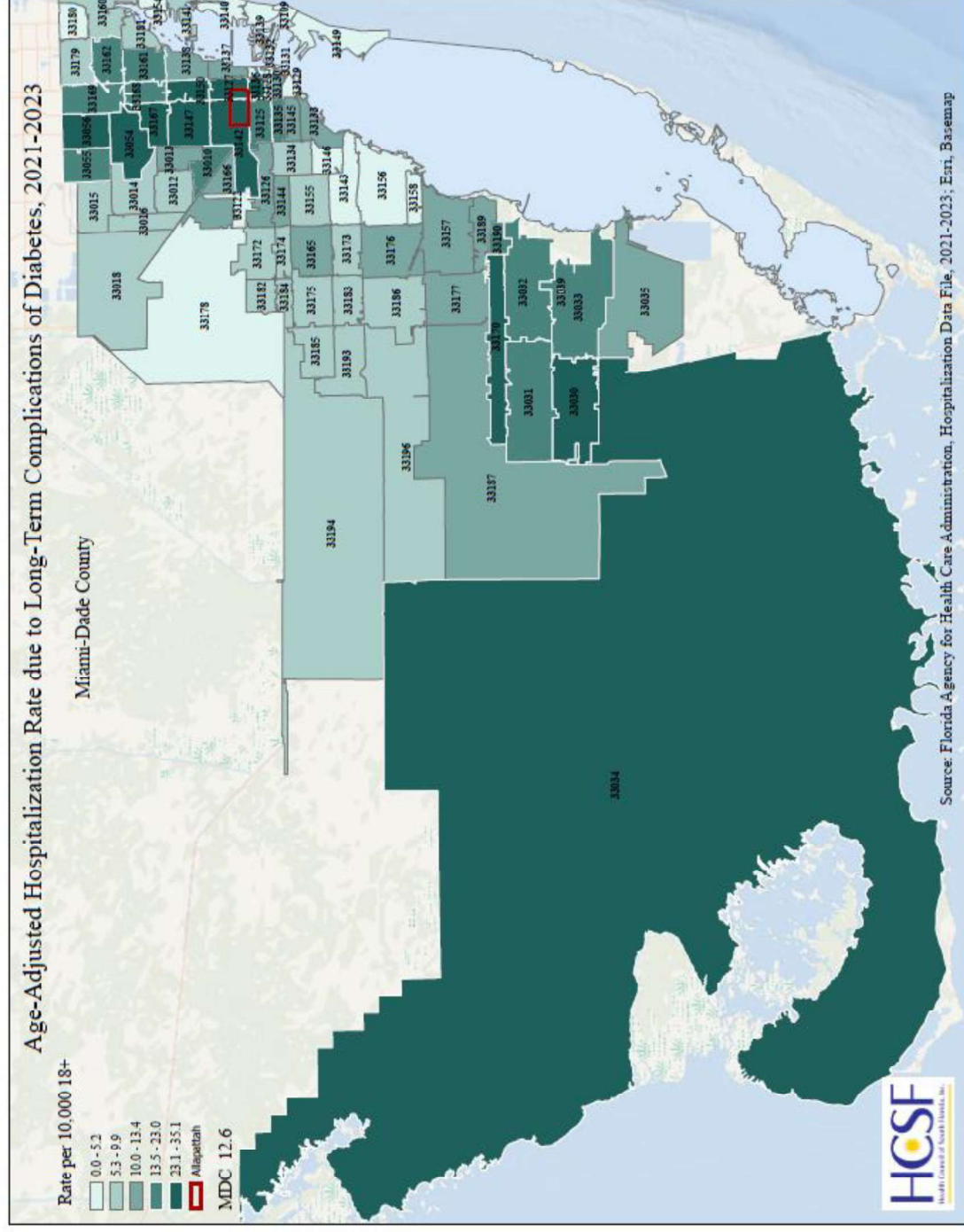

# Community Profile: Key Demographics

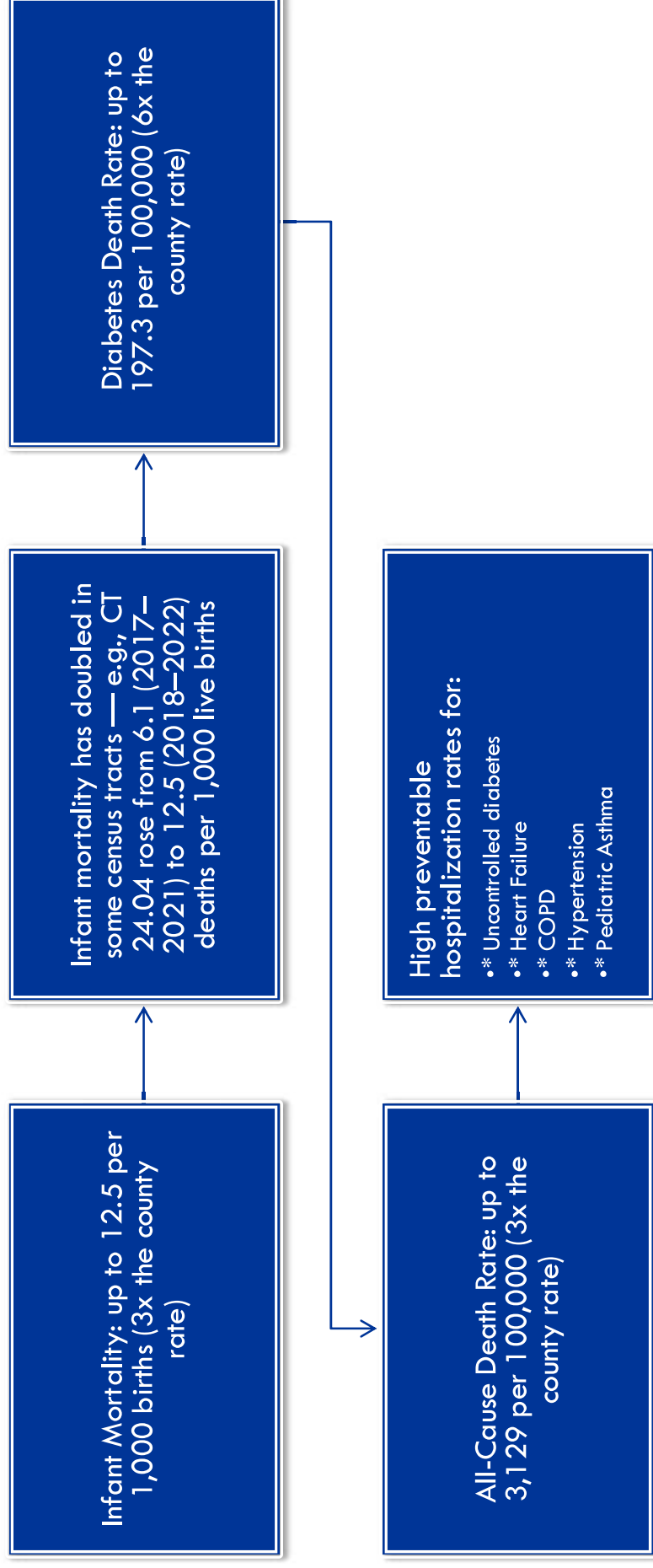
Poverty: up to 39% of

- - the percentage of HH income below poverty level in Allapattah ranges between **25%** to **39.2%**, compared to the county level of **16.6%**

Education: only 8.2% of  
residents hold a bachelor's  
degree; compared to the  
county level of 20.2%

Nearly half of households  
(47.4%) rely on SNAP benefits

# Community Focus Groups & Key Informant Interviews

- A focus group guide was developed to incorporate questions capturing resident demographics and to include questions related to the lives of the community members
  - 10 questions on the final guide
- Developed the key informant interview guide by combining various elements from sources provided by FIU
  - 11 questions on the final guide
- 3 key informant interviews conducted
- Five focus groups conducted in English and Spanish
  - 54 participants in total were interviewed



# Overarching Themes

There is a strong sense of community identity within Allapattah

- “Allapattah has a rich cultural heritage of Hispanic and Caribbean origins and that connects people and brings them outdoors”

There is a lack of resources within the community

- “There are a lot of bars, but not access to healthy foods”

While there is a lack of resources, community members take pride in the ones that are available

- “We don’t have much, but what we do have, we love”

Flooding is a huge issue

- “Water damage due to the floods is almost a common thing in Allapattah. Whether it be to homes, businesses, or cars, the water is damaging.”

Public health concerns like infestations and garbage are prevalent

- “The streets are very dirty. So much trash everywhere and that brings rats.”

Gentrification is detrimental to long-time residents of the community

- “We are going through gentrification and our neighborhood is changing. Things are getting more costly and the average income in Allapattah is not much.”

# Recommendations

 Expand preventative health & education (mobile clinics, community meetings)

 Strengthen housing support & anti-displacement policies (CLT's and assistance programs)

 Improve communication channels (flyers, text alerts, etc.)

 Address environmental hazards (cement factory, trash, lighting)

 Increase cultural competency in businesses and within healthcare (linguistics)

 Invest in youth programs and mentorship (afterschool and anti-violence programs)
